Morning Routines

We are at the end of our second week, so we are working on being more independent students. Starting next week, Monday 26th, I am asking that parents say goodbye from our line as we enter the classroom and not to walk through the classroom to assist in putting away backpacks. So far, our class has been doing an awesome job putting our backpacks away independently, or occasionally helping our friends put their backpacks away. If you plan on entering the classroom you need to be cleared

through Be a Mentor, just as a volunteer would be. Thank you for your cooperation with our new transitions.

If your child is late, within 5 minutes or more, we ask that you stop by the office to sign them in. I take attendance within the first few minutes, so when your child is late they are marked absent. Parents then get a frantic phone call saying their child is not present because they were not checked in at the office. So, it is important for the student's safety, that they are signed in at the front office when they arrive late at school. I also ask that if your child is late, and after signing them in, that you do not walk your child through the classroom to help put their backpack away. Again, we are trying to teach them to become more independent students and learners. Thank you for your cooperation!!

Please return your child's Friday Folder on Monday when returning to school. The Friday Folder helps me keep all forms, money, and other important sheets organized. It is also very important that I have their folder to send home school reminders and other important information home each Friday.
